

## **BIOSKETCH**

Philippe Pasero received his Ph.D. in Cell Biology from the University of Aix-Marseille in 1993. He was a postdoctoral fellow at ISREC (Lausanne, Switzerland) with Susan Gasser, where he studied DNA replication in budding yeast. He joined the lab of Etienne Schwob at IGMM (Montpellier, France) in 1998, where he pioneered the use of DNA combing to monitor yeast DNA replication. He started his own research group at the Institute of Human Genetics (Montpellier, France) in 2003. Research in the Pasero laboratory focuses on the cellular responses to replication stress in yeast and human cells. Philippe Pasero authored more than 90 articles, including senior author publications in *Nat Cell Biol* (2009), *Mol Cell* (2005, 2012, 2014), *Nat Struct Mol Biol* (2010), *EMBO J* (2003, 2009, 2012), *Ann Rev Genet* (2017).
