

The Associazione Italiana di Cancerologia published the ELENA CAPANNINI prize 2019 for the best publication in the field of innovative anticancer therapies.
The research paper can be a pre-clinical or clinical research work, published in the previous year in Italy, by Italian or foreign researchers strictly concerning the described topic.
Amount: 1,000 (one thousand) euros.
Deadline: May 31st 2019

Eligibility:

- be the first author (or first co-authors) of a pre-clinical or clinical research work, published in 2018 strictly concerning the described topic
- age not exceeding 40 years (on the date of the congress – see below)
- be graduated in Italy in Biological Sciences, Pharmacy, Pharmaceutical Chemistry and Technology, Medicine and Surgery, Biotechnology, Bioengineering

Candidates send the pdf file containing the following to sic@istitutotumori.mi.it:

- application form
- copy of the pre-clinical or clinical research work published in 2018 concerning the described topic
- curriculum vitae
- Copy of the identity document

In the case of two first co-authors the application must be completed and signed by both and the curricula and photocopies of the identity document of both must be attached.

The winning candidate will be notified by 31 August 2019.

The prize will be awarded during the "61st National Congress of the Italian Cancer Society", to be held in Naples on 6-8 November 2019.

The winner must be duly registered in the Congress.
