### **THE PEZCOLLER – MARINA LARCHER FOGAZZARO – EACR WOMEN IN CANCER RESEARCH AWARD**

The Pezcoller-Marina Larcher Fogazzaro-EACR Women in Cancer Research Award celebrates the achievements of women working in cancer research.

The winner gives the prestigious Pezcoller-Marina Larcher Fogazzaro-EACR Women in Cancer Research Award Lecture at the EACR Congress. The next award will be presented at the EACR 2021 Congress to be held from 09 – 12 June 2021 in Torino, Italy.

The award winner will receive a €10,000 honorarium.

The Foundation invites the nomination of cancer researchers who have demonstrated academic excellence and achievements in the field of cancer research and who have, through leadership or by example, furthered the advancement of women in cancer research. Self-nominations cannot be accepted.

### **THE PEZCOLLER FOUNDATION – EACR RISING STAR AWARD**

The Pezcoller Foundation-EACR Rising Star Award celebrates a cancer researcher who has the potential to make significant contributions to future cancer research progress. The award is presented biennially to a researcher of excellence who is within 1 – 4 years of having established their own laboratory in a European institution; and named as the first and/or last author on at least one paper published in an international peer-reviewed cancer research journal; arising from work carried out in their laboratory.

The winner gives the prestigious The Pezcoller Foundation-EACR Rising Star Award at the EACR Congress. The next award will be presented at the EACR 2021 Congress to be held from 09-12 June 2021 in Torino, Italy.

As an invited speaker the award winner will receive a free registration for the EACR Congress, plus accommodation and travel costs. The award winner will also receive a €5,000 honorarium.

The Foundation invites the nomination of cancer researchers who have demonstrated academic excellence and who show potential for exciting future achievements in the field of cancer research. Self-nominations cannot be accepted.

Nominees must meet the following criteria:

- Be within 1 to 4 years of having established their own laboratory in a European institution
- Be named as the first and/or last author on at least one paper published in an international peer-reviewed cancer research journal, arising from work carried out in their laboratory

### **THE PEZCOLLER FOUNDATION – EACR TRANSLATIONAL CANCER RESEARCHER AWARD**

Since 2012, the Pezcoller Foundation and the European Association for Cancer Research have collaborated in the organization of the biennial Pezcoller Foundation – EACR Cancer Researcher Award, which celebrates academic excellence and achievements in the field of cancer research.

From 2020, the Award has been renamed the Pezcoller Foundation – EACR Translational Cancer Researcher Award and will be made annually from 2021 onwards.

Nominations will be accepted for cancer researchers who have demonstrated academic excellence and meet the following criteria:

- Have no more than 15 years post-doctoral experience (or equivalent degree)
- Are currently employed in a European institution
- Have a record of employment in Europe of at least five years

Self-nominations cannot be accepted.

The winner:

- will receive a €10,000 honorarium from the Pezcoller Foundation
- will give the prestigious Pezcoller Foundation – EACR Translational Cancer Researcher Award Lecture at the EACR Congress.
- will receive from the EACR a free registration plus accommodation and travel costs as an invited speaker to the EACR Congress.
